As part of the Voluntary section of the Ofsted Childcare Register (OCR), nannies and childminders can now register in order that their employers can benefit from any government or company childcare benefits, such as child tax credits/working tax credits and childcare vouchers.

Tinies Training offers the appropriate qualifications to nannies to support their application for approval and registration. This includes:

- **12 hours, 2 day Paediatric First Aid** qualification (valid for 3 years)
- The **Introduction to Child Care Practice** (Home-based) (ICP) / Common Core course which is a 12 hour course over 2 days and covers the main areas of child care practice for home based carers

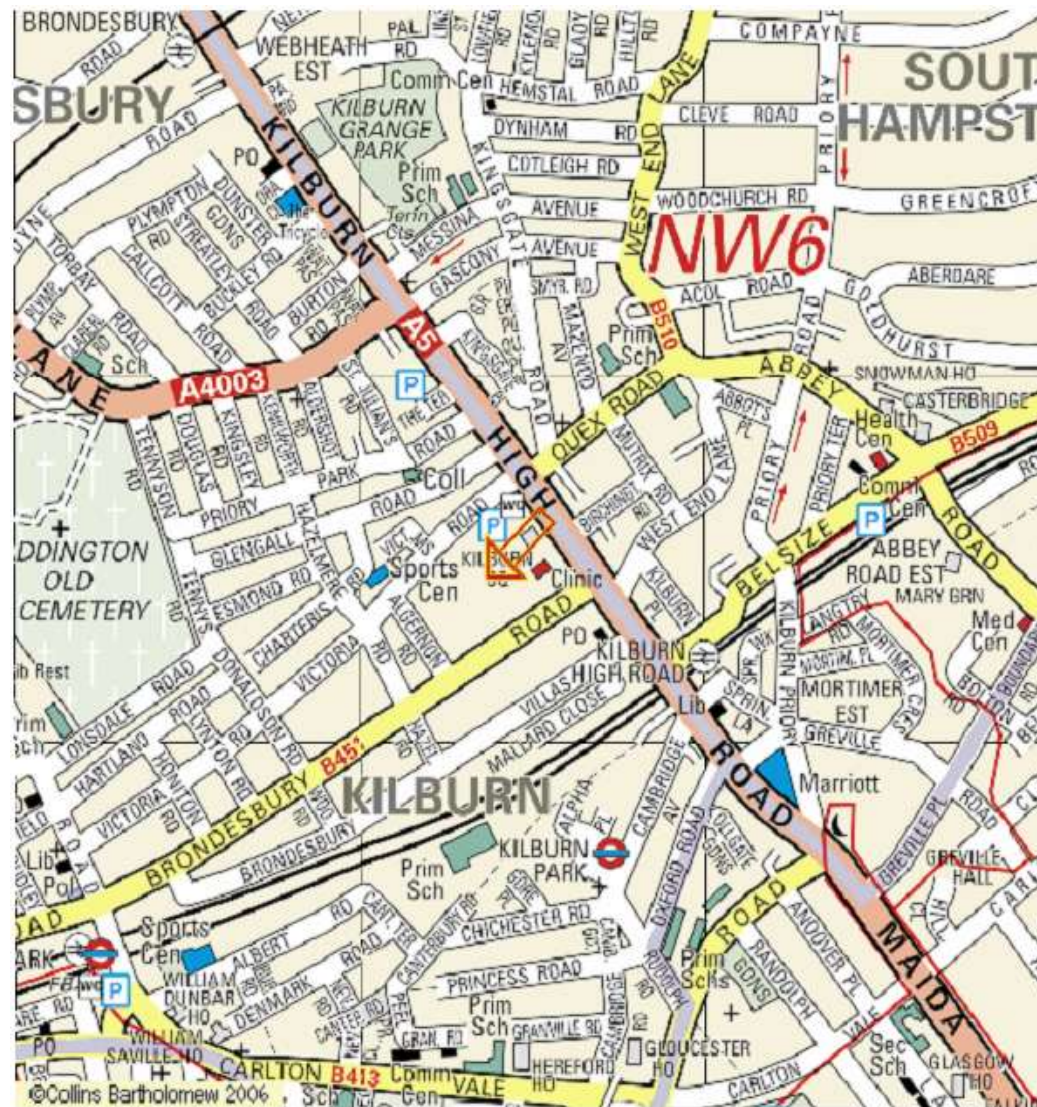

CACHE Accredited Awards

Tinies Training assessment centre is approved for CACHE awards, including:

- **Level 3 Diploma for Children & Young Peoples Workforce**
- **Level 4 Certificate in Managing Quality Standards in Children's Services**
- **Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health & Social Care and Children and Young People's Management Pathway or Advanced Practice Pathway**

How the TINIES courses work is that the candidate secures a placement. One of our TINIES ASSESSORS would then come to their workplace. The benefit of this is that candidates can potentially be earning a full time wage whilst studying and not have to take study leave to attend a local college or training centre. As we have no intake periods we can commence a qualification at a time to suit the individual learner.

Entry level depends on the individual learner as to what suits them. If you wish to study with Tinies Training, we will ask that you simply complete an enrolment form and submit with an up to date CV, including your duties in your current job role. A decision is usually made within 48 hours or less

Entry requirements

Criteria is linked to the various qualifications and information is provided by Tinies based on the requirements set out by the awarding body, but briefly

- Level 3 Diploma requires that the Learner is working or volunteering a total of 18+ hours a week in an approved setting
- Level 4 Certificate is an academic qualification aimed at management level
- Level 5 Diploma is for those who preferably have the Level 3 Diploma and are currently employed at a certain level of responsibility , able to evidence management level capabilities

Funding for DCYPW/ NVQ's

Tinies Training and CACHE do not deal with funding for qualifications. But you might like to discuss the matter further with your **local authority** as they have access to funding for continuous development depending on your personal circumstances. Loans may be available through the **Skills Council**
