Your children & babies learn through first hand experience in a holistic manner. They have a natural desire to learn and to make sense of their environment through playing and using their senses. Our crèche allows them to develop at their own rate with the focus on what they can do rather than what they can't. Play is your child's work, enabling them to make sense of the world around them, exploring and experiencing within the safety of a supervised and caring environment.

The Bank of England crèche has been designed specifically with this in mind. Our activities are designed to create that special range of experiences (physical, intellectual, social



and emotional), enabling your child to embrace knowledge at his or her own pace. Allowing you to really enjoy your time confident that your child is having fun and learning through play.

We pride ourselves on the wide range of activities we provide. So please look out for our regular 8 weekly plan of everything going on in your site.

Opening times:

Monday - Saturday 9.30 - 12.30pm

Minimum Stay is one hour and thirty minutes thereafter.

Prices:

£7.50 per hour for ad-hoc bookings

£5.50 per hour for advanced block bookings of 10 hours or more

£11 per hour for Non Members

(Non-member children may either be children of parents who are members or an accompanying friend of a member child)

Sessional Care

Available from 9.30am - 1.30pm term time only, please see staff for more details.

Booking procedure

Within our crèche we work to specified ratios of childcarers to children. Places do go quickly, so booking in advance helps secure your place but also helps us to keep to these ratios.

Cancellations and amendments should be made a minimum of 24 hours prior to crèche booking, to avoid any surcharges or fines.

Ages

We cater for children from 3 months to 5 years.

Your expectations of us

- We will smile and greet everyone big or small who comes to our crèche
- We will plan & provide creative programmes to inspire your children
- We will ask for your feedback

- We will make sure that your child is always provided with a drink
- We will change nappies as required, but ask that you please provide your own nappies, wipes and a nappy sack in a labelled bag
- We will always tell you what your child has been doing while they have been in our crèche

We have a few expectations of you

- Please do not bring your child in if they have been unwell in the last 24 hours. This is for comfort of your child and also the health of the other children
- Please tell us of any changes to the information on the crèche registration card as soon as possible
- Please bring spare clothes for your child and remember to label any bags, bottles, cups
- Book in and out at the crèche reception on each visit. This is in accordance with fire regulations
- Please don't forget to drop off and collect your child at the allocated time

Settling in policy

Every child requires time to settle into a new environment. Our crèche team will work really hard, in partnership with you, to settle your child into our crèche environment.

You're really welcome to stay with your children until you feel comfortable and your child feels "at home" in our crèche.

We suggest that you book only 1-hour sessions for your first few visits. Please be aware it's our policy to call you back if your child is distressed and cannot be distracted or comforted within 15 minutes.

Infectious disease information

Chickenpox: Incubation: 21 days
Isolation: 5 - 10 days from onset of rash

Conjunctivitis: Isolation: Please allow 24 hours after your child's first treatment before entering the crèche

Diarrhoea: Isolation: Please allow 48 hours after your child's last loose stool before entering the crèche

Measles: Incubation: 10 - 15 days
Isolation: 5 days from onset of rash

Mumps: Incubation: 12 - 26 days
Isolation: Until swelling has subsided

German Measles: Incubation: 14 - 21 days
Isolation: 5 days from onset of rash

Fire safety

In case of a fire, please go directly to the meeting point where the Crèche staff will escort your children.
